STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Voting Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 13, amended. The 1st sentence of section 13 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The municipal officers, 60 days before any election, may, after public notice and hearing, divide towns and wards of cities into not more than 3 convenient voting districts.'
