AN ACT Relating to Fees for Certified Copies of Check-Lists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 25, amended. Section 25 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 25. Clerks to preserve check-lists, and furnish certified copies thereof. Clerks of towns shall preserve the check-lists used at any election at which the ballots cast are to be returned to the secretary of state under the provisions of this chapter, for 1 year without alteration, and shall furnish to any person a certified copy thereof within 20 days after demand and payment or tender of ~~the legal charges~~ **the following fees, from 1 to 500 names, 1c per name; from 500 to 1,000 names, ½c per name; from 1,000 to 5,000 names, ¼c per name; for all lists containing more than 5,000 names, \$15 therefor,** and shall without charge furnish the governor and council with a certified copy thereof within 20 days after demand, under the penalty provided in section 97.'
