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**RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction at the Maine State Airport.**

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**Maine state airport; appropriation for construction. Resolved:** That the sum of \$143,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be used with matching federal funds for extension of the northwest-southeast runway and lighting system at the state airport, at Augusta, so said airport may be usable and safe for present air traffic.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The present runway, 3400', is wholly inadequate for present traffic, dangerous to use, and the airport presently is by-passed by larger executive-type civilian planes, many military planes, and by 1953 will be totally unusable for the airlines under CAA regulations. The appropriation will allow an extension to 4200' and improvement of lighting.
