**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Moving Maine Vocational-  
Technical Institute.**

---

**Maine vocational-technical institute; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$90,000 to move Maine vocational-technical institute from Augusta to Fort Preble, in South Portland, and to recondition the buildings at Fort Preble; and be it further

**Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952 and the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953 for maintenance of Maine vocational-technical institute.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The buildings at Fort Preble are available to the state as a free grant for educational purposes. Such gift will afford dormitory facilities for the students which are not available in Augusta.
