STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Billboard Liquor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 59, amended. Section 59 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hreeby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 59. Advertising of liquor regulated. No advertising of liquor within the state shall be permitted except in such form as may be specifically authorized by the commission, provided that radio, billboards, signs, newspapers, magazines and periodicals, and outside signs as provided in section 58, but excluding billboards, may carry advertising subject to the regulations of the commission.'
