STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Licenses in Unincorporated Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 21-A, amended. The last paragraph of section 21-A of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'; and provided further, that no license shall be issued in any unincorporated place of a type disapproved by a negative vote on any local option question in any adjoining incorporated place, and where any adjoining incorporated place voted on all local option questions in the negative, no liquor licenser of any kind shall be issued in any adjoining unincorporated place nor shall any liquor store be operated therein.'
