STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of Sporting Camps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 30, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 30 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A sporting camp, under the provisions of this section, shall include any camp, lodge or building regularly or temporarily open for hunting and fishing parties as distinguished from private dwellings, and which are situated in any of the towns or unorganized townships in the state.'
