STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Rules and Regulations Issued by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 6th paragraph thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Whenever any lake or pond of less than 2 square miles in area or any brook or stream or part thereof is stocked with legal size fish by the department of inland fisheries and game, the commissioner may close said pond by rule and regulation for not more than 1 month. Rules and regulations so issued shall be published once in a newspaper in the county where the waters concerned are situated and shall become effective on the date of publication.'
