AN ACT Relating to Licenses of Buildings for Dancing Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 53-A, amended. Section 53-A of chapter 88 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 272 of the public laws of 1947 and amended by chapter 235 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby further amended by striking out the period in the last sentence thereof and adding the following:

'if the building code requirements with respect to places used for dancing are equivalent to the requirements of this section and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.'
