Amend said Amendment by striking out the paragraph designated "Sec. 109-A" and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

" 'Sec. 109-A. Following fire apparatus prohibited.

The driver of any motor vehicle shall not follow any fire apparatus traveling in response to a fire alarm closer than 500 feet."
