SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1038, L. D.603,  
Bill "An Act Relating to Motor Vehicles  
Following Fire Apparatus and Crossing Fire  
Hose."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the paragraph  
designated "Sec. 109-A" and inserting in place thereof the  
following paragraph:

" 'Sec. 109-A. Following fire apparatus prohibited.  
The driver of any motor vehicle shall not follow any fire  
apparatus traveling in response to a fire alarm closer than 500  
feet."
