## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

### AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge and the Recorder of the Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1909, c. 393, § 15, amended.** Section 15 of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by chapter 98 of the private and special laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder; clerk hire. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all services, of \$1,500 \$2,100 per annum to be paid him by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of \$1,500 \$1,500 per annum, payable quarterly monthly, and such additional amount for clerk hire as may be authorized by the county commissioners.'
