STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Authorizing Clerk Hire for the South Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 242, § 23, Item VIII, amended. The last sentence of Item VIII of section 23 of chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1895, as enacted by chapter 24 of the private and special laws of 1937 and amended by chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The recorder shall receive a salary of \$600 per year from the 1st day of January, 1943 and \$600 annually additional for clerk hire.'
