AN ACT Relating to Transporting Children in Open Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 123-A, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 123-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 123-A. Transporting children in trucks, regulated. No child under the age of 18 years shall be transported in or on any part of a truck except the cab unless the operator or owner shall take all reasonable precautions for the safety of such passengers.’
