**AN ACT Amending the Charter of the City of Waterville to Allow Red
Blinker Lights on Motor Vehicles of Callmen of Fire Department.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1887, c. 195, § 5-A, additional. Chapter 195 of the private and special laws of 1887, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 5-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5-A. Lights on motor vehicles of callmen of fire department. All volunteer callmen, members of the Waterville fire department in good standing, shall be allowed to install on vehicles which they own, in a prominent place on the forward part thereof, 1 red light of the kind and size used by emergency vehicles in this state; said lights, however, to be used only by said members of the fire department in the actual performance of their duties as members of that department.'
