STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to a State Police Barrack in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Establishment of a barrack. The governor and council are hereby directed and authorized to purchase such land in the county of Somerset for the use of the state as may be necessary for the erection of a state police barrack. There shall be erected, equipped and maintained, under the supervision of the chief of the state police, on said land in the county of Somerset, a state police barrack.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$50,000 from the general fund for the purchase of said land and the erection and equipping of said barrack. All unexpended balances shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until expended for the purposes mentioned in section 1.
