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**AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Members of Employment Security  
Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 24, § 4, sub-§ II, amended.** Subsection II of section 4 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 430 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'II. Salaries.** The chairman of the commission shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of ~~\$6,000~~ \$7,000 per year, and each of the other members shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of ~~\$5,500~~ \$6,500 per year, and shall be paid from the employment security administration fund.'
