# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

## AN ACT Relating to Open Season on White Perch.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§§ I, III, IV, amended. Subsections I, III and IV of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, are hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 'I. For salmon, trout and togue and white perch in lakes and ponds, there shall be an open season from the time the ice is out in the spring season until September 30th; and for white perch in lakes and ponds there shall be an open season from July 1 to September 30.'
  - 'III. There shall be an open season for salmon, trout and togue and white perch in all the rivers above tidewater from the time the ice is out in the spring until September 15th. There shall be an open season for white perch in all the rivers above tidewater from July 1 to September 15. Provided, however, it shall be lawful to fish Big Magalloway river in Oxford county between Aziscohos lake and Parmachenee dam until September 30th with artificial unbaited flies with a daily limit after September 15th of 1 fish per day per person.

'IV. There shall be an open season for salmon, trout and togue and white perch in brooks and streams from the time the ice is out in the spring season until August 15th. There shall be an open season for white perch in brooks and streams from July 1 to August 15.'
