RESOLVE Closing Keewaydin Lake, Oxford County, to Ice Fishing for Salmon and Trout.

Keewaydin lake; closed to ice fishing for salmon and trout. Resolved; That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the taking of salmon and trout through the ice from Keewaydin lake in the town of Stoneham, Oxford county.
