SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 309, L. D. 660,
Bill "An Act Relating to the Superintending
School Committee of the Town of Houlton."

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end thereof a new
paragraph to read as follows:

'Referendum. This act shall take effect 90 days after the
adjournment of the legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its
submission to the qualified voters of the town of Houlton at the next
annual town meeting held not later than 1 year after the effective
date of this act. Said meeting shall be called, advertised and con-
ducted according to the law relating to municipal elections, a proper
article being inserted in the call for said meeting. The town clerk
shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question:
"Shall the Act Relating to the Superintending School Committee of the
Town of Houlton, passed by the 95th legislature, be accepted," and
the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed over the
words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take
effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by
a majority of the legal voters voting at said meeting. The result of
said vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the town of
Houlton and due certificate thereof shall be filed by the town clerk
with the secretary of state.'
