STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Superintending School Committee of the Town of Houlton.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 3, § 2, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 2 of chapter 3 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'At such annual town meetings, the voters shall elect by ballot as hereinafter provided, 7 persons who are qualified to vote in said town to be known as councillors, and $\frac{1}{2}$ member or 5 members of the superintending school committee, in accordance with the revised statutes of 1930 and amendments thereto I of the 2 additional members shall be elected for a term of 4 years and the other shall be elected for a term of 5 years, and thereafter I member shall be elected each year for a term of 5 years, a town clerk, a town treasurer, and an auditor of accounts.'
