STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Recorder of the Bar Harbor Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1899, c. 61, § 3, amended. The last sentence of section 3 of chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1899, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 203 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall receive as compensation for his services the sum of six hundred dollars \$700 a year to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county of Hancock, which will be in full for his services.'
