IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Relief of Paupers in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 82, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 82 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 3rd sentence thereof, a new sentence to read as follows:

'The state shall reimburse any town which incurs expense by reason of its overseers performing duties for paupers who are found in places not incorporated.'
