RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Repairs on Convent on Indian Island Reservation.

Convent on Indian Island Reservation; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,200 to be expended for repairs on the Convent on Indian Island Reservation, at Old Town; this money to be expended on authorization of the department of health and welfare.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Minor repairs on the Convent on Indian Island Reservation, Old Town, Maine, have been made from time to time from funds appropriated to the Penobscot Tribe. The repairs now needed are too expensive to be financed from the appropriation for the Penobscot Tribe. It has been requested that consideration be given to resolve to take care of these repairs.
