## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Members of the State Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 3, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 3 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the state highway commission shall receive an annual salary of \$3,500 \$4,500; they shall also receive their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties while away from their homes.'
