RESOLVE, in Favor of the Waterford Fish and Game Association.

Waterford Fish and Game Association; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$180 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to reimburse the Waterford Fish and Game Association for its share in the construction of a fish screen at the mouth of Bear pond, in the town of Waterford, county of Oxford.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount of this resolve represents $\frac{1}{2}$ of the cost of the screen. The Waterford Fish and Game Association paid the full amount and they are now asking for reimbursement for the amount which should have been paid by the state.
