**RESOLVE, Relating to the Use of Seines in Medomak River, Lincoln
County.**

Medomak river; use of seines. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the use of any purse, drag or stop seines in Medomak river, above a line drawn from the southerly end of Hevener's Point in the town of Waldoboro, easterly to the northerly end of Jones' Neck in said town of Waldoboro, except for the taking of smelts.
