RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Notched Pond in Cumberland County.

Notched pond, ice fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Notched Pond, in the towns of Raymond and Gray, Cumberland county, to ice fishing on Monday only of each week during the month of February.
