COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1121, L. D. 708, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Ogunquit Village Corporation."

Amend said bill by striking out the entire emergency preamble.

Further amend said bill by inserting in the second line of Sec. 8, after the word "manager" the punctuation and word '. removal'.

Further amend Sec. 8, by adding after the last sentence, this additional sentence:

'The corporation manager shall serve at the pleasure of the board of overseers and he may be removed by them by a majority vote at any regular meeting of the board of overseers, after notice of their intentions have been publicly announced at the preceding regular meeting of said board.'

Further amend said bill by striking out the entire Emergency clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Referendum; effective date. This act shall not take effect unless and until accepted and approved by a majority vote of the legal voters of the Ogunquit Village Corporation at the annual meeting held on April, 1952. The corporation clerk shall prepare the required ballots on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following questions: "Shall 'An Act Relating to the Ogunquit Village Corporation', passed by the 95th Legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. The result shall be declared by the overseers of the corporation and due certificate thereof filed by the corporation clerk with the secretary of state. This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters of said village corporation voting at said meeting.
