## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Authorized Amount of Endowment for Bridge Academy in the Town of Dresden.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1891, c. 286, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 286 of the private and special laws of 1891 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Powers and privileges. Said corporation is hereby vested with all the powers, rights, privileges and immunities incident to similar corporations, may have and use a common seal, prosecute and defend suits at law, make and establish by-laws and regulations for the management of its affairs and the proper government of the academy, not repugnant to the constitution and laws of the state, and hold estate, real and personal, which it may now have, or may hereafter receive by gift, grant, devise, purchase or otherwise, to an amount not exceeding two hundred thousand dollars \$400,000.'
