**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Open Time on Rabbits in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 95, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 95 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive; except in the counties of Franklin and Oxford ~~and Somerset~~ where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive; and except in the county of Waldo, where there shall be a closed season from the 16th day of March to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive.'
