COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1175, L. D. 731, Bill "An Act
Relating to Dumping of Rubbish in Highways."

Amend said bill by striking out all of the same and substitute
in place thereof the following:

R. S., c. 124, §24, repealed and replaced. Section 24 of
chapter 124 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the
following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 24. Dumping of rubbish in highways forbidden; penalty.
No person, firm or corporation shall throw, place or cause to be
placed any waste material, bottles, rubbish or garbage of any
nature within the limits of the right of way of any public highway;
provided, however, that this section shall not apply to the proper
use of the right of way for highway purposes.

For the purposes of this section, where the limits of the
highway are not known, they shall be considered as extending 33
feet both sides of the center line of the travelled portion of the
highway.

Whoever violates the provision of this section shall be
punished by a fine of not more than \$50.'
