STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Western Somerset Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1909, c. 331, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 331 of the private and special laws of 1909 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Where regular terms shall be held. Regular terms of said court for the transaction of civil business shall be held as follows:

At Skowhegan, on the 1st Monday of every month excepting August, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

At Fairfield, on the 2nd Monday of January, March, May, July, September and November, at nine 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

At Madison, on the last Monday of every month excepting July, at nine-thirty 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

At Bingham, on the 2nd Monday of February, April, June, October and December, at eleven 10 o'clock in the forenoon.'

Provided, however, that no writ or process which is dated before the effective date of this act, but made returnable after the effective date of this act, shall be dismissed because the hour on the return date is erroneous.
