# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Digging of Clams in the Town of St. George.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 61, amended. Chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows.

'The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to that part of the town of St. George that borders on the St. George river from the South Thomaston town line to Marshall's Point light house, Port Clyde.'
