RESOLVE, Closing Certain Waters in Hancock County to Taking of Salt Water Smelts.

Salt water smelts; certain waters closed to taking of. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing all brooks and rivers to the taking of salt water smelts, in any manner, in the towns of Brooklin, Bluehill, Surry, Ellsworth, Trenton, Lamoine, Franklin, Sullivan and Gouldsboro during the months of March, April and May of each year; except that it shall be legal to take smelts by hand or hand dip nets, in the amount of 4 quarts to a person, in the following designated brooks and rivers during the months above named, on any one tide:

Flanders stream, in the town of Sullivan,

Scammons pond stream, in the town of Franklin (West Franklin),

Egypt stream, in the town of Franklin,

Union river, in the town of Ellsworth, all in the county of Hancock.
