RESOLVE, Authorizing a Reclassification of Highways.

Reclassification of highways authorized. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to study the present classification of highways in the state and to reclassify all highways now designated as state or state aid highways on a basis of traffic and benefits rendered as provided by section 5 and section 15 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes. The state highway commission is authorized and directed to employ an impartial and non-profit consulting organization experienced in the field of highway planning and administration in connection with this study and is further authorized to pay the cost of such a study out of the general highway fund.
