**AN ACT Relating to State Owned Cars for State Fire Marshal and
Inspectors.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 29, amended. The 1st sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 29 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 390 of the public laws of 1947, and as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘The state shall provide no automobiles for travel of employees; provided, however, that this shall not apply to the governor, the state police, department of inland fisheries and game, department of sea and shore fisheries, inspectors in the motor vehicle division of the secretary of state, supervisors in the Maine forestry district, highway department, **state fire marshal, state fire inspectors**, nor to such heads of departments or members of commissions as the governor and council may from time to time designate.’
