COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1204, L. D. 762, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Elections in the City of
Biddeford."

Amend said bill by striking out in Sec. 2, the seventh line,
the word "2nd" and inserting in place thereof the word '1st'.

Further amend said bill by striking out in Sec. 2-A, in the
eighth line, the word "second" and inserting in place thereof the
word 'first'.

Further amend said bill by adding before section 4 thereof the
following section:

"Sec. 4. P. & S. L., 1933, c. 66, §16, amended. The 4th
sentence of section 16 of chapter 66 of the private and special laws
of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
'Said officers shall be elected by ballot by a ~~plurality~~ majority of
the votes given, and they shall hold their office for 1 year from the
1st day of January following their election in December, and until
others shall be elected and qualified in their stead.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined
abbreviation and figure "Sec. 4." at the beginning of the last
paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 5.'
