STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 95th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1204, L. D. 762, Bill "An Act Relating to Elections in the City of Biddeford."

Amend said bill by adding at the end thereof the following: 'This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the City of Biddeford at the next general election thereon. For the purpose of such election, the city clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: 'Shall An Act Relating to Elections in the City of Biddeford, passed by the 95th legislature, be approved?', and the voters shall indicate by a cross, placed within a square upon their ballots, over the words 'Yes' or 'No! their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all purposes of this act immediately upon the acceptance of this act at the above election. The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers and certificate thereof filed by the city clerk with the secretary of state.
