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**AN ACT Amending the Charter of the City of Saco Relative to Voting.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1867, c. 215, § 11, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 11 of chapter 215 of the private and special laws of 1867 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All said officers shall be elected by ballot by a ~~majority~~ plurality of the votes given, and shall hold their offices for 1 year from the 3rd Monday in March, and until others shall be elected in their places; provided, however, that if the city shall be divided into less than 7 wards, then 1 or 2 (as the case may be) of the aldermen shall be elected at large by the inhabitants of the city, the whole number of aldermen in no case to be more than 7, as provided in section 2 of this act.'
