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AN ACT Relating to Tax Lien Fees.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 81, § 97, amended.** The last sentence of section 97 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The costs to be paid by the town and charged to the taxpayer for said notice and filing shall be \$2 together with the cost of registered mail and also the sum of \$1 to be charged by the register of deeds for such filing shall be \$1 for the notice plus registered mail fee, and \$1 for filing lien, said sums to be payable to the tax collector, and \$1 payable to the register of deeds for recording, and the fee for recording the discharge of such lien shall be 75c.'
