STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "Moosehead Trail."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. "Moosehead Trail," designated. The following described highway is hereby designated as the "Moosehead Trail": Beginning in Belfast at the junction of routes No. 1 and No. 7 and extending to Doxer Foxcroft on Route No. 7 and thence extending to Rockwood on route No. 15.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 74, repealed. Chapter 74 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby repealed.
