STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Issuance of Liquor Licenses to Places Selling Gasoline.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-E, amended. Section 22-E of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 259 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd sentence thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No license shall be issued to any person, partnership, association or corporation engaging in the sale of gasoline upon or adjoining the premises sought to be licensed.'
