SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1243, L. D. 795, Bill "An Act
Relating to Examination of Certain School
Bus Operators."

Amend said Bill by striking out subsections I and III of that
part designated "Sec. 53-A" thereof.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in subsection V of
that part designated "Sec. 53-A" thereof the underlined words
"at least 30 days before" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined words 'within 30 days after'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering, in that part
designated "Sec. 53-A" thereof, subsection II to be subsection I;
subsection IV to be subsection II; subsection V to be subsection
III; and subsection VI to be subsection IV.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following underlined paragraph:

'The operator of a school bus under the provisions of this
section, on returning the children to their homes from the public
school, shall discharge such children at the place where they first
entered the bus to be transported to the public school.'
