STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Drive-In Theaters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 88, §§ 68-A and 68-B, additional. Chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto 2 new sections, to be numbered 68-A and 68-B, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 68-A. Drive-in- theaters. No entrance to or exit from any drive-in theater hereafter erected shall be from a state or state aid highway. No screen of a drive-in theater hereafter erected on which a motion picture is projected shall be constructed in such a manner that the projected motion picture may be viewed from a state or state aid highway. In addition, the provisions of sections 65 to 68, inclusive, as far as applicable, shall apply to drive-in theaters.
- Sec. 68-B. Rules and regulations. The insurance commissioner is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of sections 65 to 68-A, inclusive.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 88, § 71, amended. Section 71 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'Sec. 71. Penalties. Whoever keeps, uses or operates any cinemato-

graph or similar apparatus contrary to the provisions of the 6 8 preceding sections shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25, nor more than \$500, to be recovered on complaint or indictment to the use of the city or town in which any such violation occurs.'
