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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED  
FIFTY-ONE**

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**AN ACT Relating to Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corporation.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1911, c. 216, § 6, amended.** Section 6 of chapter 216 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 6. Corporation may adopt by-laws, etc.** The said corporation at any legal meeting called for the purpose, may adopt such by-laws and provisions not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of this state, as they may deem efficient for the better government of the corporation, by a  $\frac{2}{3}$  vote of those present and voting, and it may also adopt by a  $\frac{2}{3}$  vote of those present and voting, ordinances for planning and zoning with all the privileges and rights, and subject to all of the restrictions and limitations, imposed upon cities and towns by the provisions of chapter 80 of the revised statutes of 1944, as amended.'
