RESOLVE, Authorizing Forest Commissioner to Renew Lease to Passamaquoddy Lumber Company.

Forest commissioner authorized to renew lease. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to renew the lease dated December 6, 1950 whereby the state of Maine did lease unto the Passamaquoddy Lumber Company a piece of land in Indian township for a period of 3 years, said renewal to be in accordance with the terms and conditions described in said lease.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under date of December 6, 1950, the commissioner of the department of health and welfare, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 22, section 361, leased a piece of land in Indian township to the Passamaquoddy Lumber Company for the term of 3 years, starting December 1, 1950. The lease provides for an option to renew for a period of 2 years. If the act repealing section 361, chapter 22, is passed this resolve will give authority to the forest commissioner to renew this lease in accordance with its provisions.
