AN ACT Relating to Fluoride in Public Water Supplies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 122-B, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 122-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 122-B. Fluoride in public waters; rules and regulations. No municipality, water district, individual or any agency operating a public water supply shall add any fluoride to any such water supply without written approval of the department of health and welfare. The department is authorized to make such rules and regulations as it deems necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.'
