STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Disposition of Costs in Inland Fisheries and Game and Sea and Shore Fisheries Violations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 110, amended. The 1st sentence of section 110 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'All fines, penalties and all other moneys recovered by the court under any provision of this chapter shall accrue to the treasurer of state and shall be paid into the treasury of the county where the offense is prosecuted. All court costs shall accrue to the county where the offense is committed.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 34, § 143, amended. Section 143 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:
- 'All court costs shall accrue to the county where the offense is committed.'
