STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Funeral Expenses Under Old Age Assistance Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 269, amended. Section 269 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 269. Funeral expenses of person assisted. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$160 shall be paid by the state if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'
